Remedial Action for Students' feedback

The students feel that the sequence of units in the syllabus is not in the order, the same will be informed to the University for taking necessary measures to rearrange the syllabus in the sequential manner in order to have the flow of subjects.

Remedial Action for Teachers' feedback

As per the syllabus prescribed by the university at the PG level especially MCA the number of teaching hours allotted to each unit is less than the actual teaching hours that is to be required. The most of the concepts cannot be clearly delivered in the prescribed hours because of this the students have to spend more number of hours in gathering information from various sources such as library, internet which increases the load on the students, the same will be informed to the University for taking necessary measures to rearrange the syllabus in the sequential manner in order to have the flow of subjects.

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Remedial Action for Alumni feedback

The practical component in the subject is lacking. Alumni are of the opinion that more of the practical components should be included as per changing needs of the industry, the same has been informed to the University for taking necessary measures to rearrange the syllabus in the sequential manner in order to have the flow of subjects.

Remedial Action for parent feedback

More of the student development programs are to be included for providing quality teaching and overall development of the students. This was discussed in the board of Governors meeting and it was suggested by the governing council members to organize students' development program such as conferences, add on courses, career counseling and guidance.



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
