

REPORT ON MELANGE 2016



Debate is competitive in nature while group discussion is a co-operative group process. In a debate, a speaker can speak either 'for' the topic or 'against' the topic whereas in a GD, the speaker can express both. The final decision or result in a debate depends on voting while in a GD, the group reaches group consensus.



Students of all the departments participated enthusiastically collected different kinds of materials to portray their imagination. Overall the event was a success.





A Report on "Our Voice" Round 3 : Debate organized by The Firm Club on 6.9.2016

The first round of "Our Voice" was Pick & Speak, held on Tuesday the 5th of September. Candidates had 1 minute to prepare on a random topic, given on the spot, and had 1 minute to speak about the topic. Out of 33 candidates, 20 were chosen to proceed to the next round.

The next round was held on the 8th of September in the Seminar Hall, from 02:00 to 04:00. It saw the 30 candidates being put in 5 groups of 6 participants. A group was given a topic and the candidates had 1 minute each to present their views on that topic. Moreover, after that 1 minute each, they had a total of 5 minutes to discuss further points and to counter-argument each other.

The final round was held on the 11th of September in the UG Building's Seminar Hall, from 02:00 to 04:00. From the 20 candidates of Round 2, 8 finalists were chosen for the Debate Round. They were put in 2 groups of 4 and given 2 different topics. Professor Shanker and Professor Murthy presided over as the judge for the Debate Round.

Objectives

- **To foster critical thinking and listening skills.** Students involved in Speech & Debate develop higher-level thinking skills through application, analysis, synthesis, evaluation and creativity. They come to understand what they believe about the issues that confront them in our culture and why.
- **Increased problem-solving abilities** and overall academic performance. Various studies have shown that students who regularly participate in speech and debate activities tend to perform better than their peers in academic studies and tests.
- **To develop Research skills.** Speech and debate students learn more about their world and current affairs, its policies and value system which affect them and their communities as a whole.
- **To encourage Impromptu thinking and speaking.**

- **To build confidence under pressure.** Very often, students engaged in debates have to present compelling responses under pressure and should not waver on their points. Such situations provide a stimulus for building confidence under pressure, a skill which is crucial to survive in one's professional life.


Event Procedure

- Out of the 8 finalists, 2 groups of 4 students each were formed. The 2 groups each had their own distinct topics. From Group A, 2 students had to debate for and 2 students had to debate against. Each had 2 minutes to present their views. After the 4 candidates spoke, they had now 8 more minutes to debate between themselves. Once the deliberation was over, the Best Speaker was chosen from Group A. The same procedure ensued for Group B and another Best Speaker was chosen.
- The 2 Best Speakers were then given another topic on the spot and had 2 minutes each to present their views. The final leg of Round 3 consisted of 5 minutes of debate between the 2 speakers, out of which a winner was declared. A Question & Answer session also ensued throughout the debate, whereby the audience had the opportunity to ask questions to the participants regarding their debate topics.

The next round was held on the 8th of September in the Seminar Hall, from 02:00 to 04:00. It saw the 30 candidates being put in 5 groups of 6 participants. A group was given a topic and the candidates had 1 minute each to present their views on that topic. Moreover, after that 1 minute each, they had a total of 5 minutes to discuss further points and to counter-argument each other.

Candidates were also encouraged to use 'signal words' when supplementing or refuting arguments, a feat which only 1 or 2 students did. The HOD of the Science Department Prof. Murthy was the judge for this round. The participants came from different streams of various semesters: 1st, 3rd, and 5th Semester students of BBA, B.Com and BCA.

Objectives

- A GD round is ideally conducted in order to understand a candidate's interpersonal skills. Since group discussions in an interview involve discussing topics with individuals you have never interacted with before, how well you're able to put across your point and are able to lead a discussion is judged upon, based on which how you can work in a team or lead them can be easily assessed.
- It also portrays to the interviewer a side of your attitude which you might probably display in your workplace.
- GD not only improves your listening skills, but also increases your confidence in speaking and helps you mould your attitude according to each group. Further, it also improves your ability to think critically and helps in problem solving.

Event Procedure

A group was given a topic and the candidates had 1 minute each to present their views on that topic. Moreover, after that 1 minute each, they had a total of 5 minutes to discuss further points and to counter-argument each other. The student is then assessed on 5 criteria of: Fluency, Body Language, Content, Presentation and Involvement in Discussion.





"Essay Writing" was conducted on 13th April 2017 at the MBA block seminar hall from 2:00pm to 4:00pm.



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
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


A Report on "Our Voice" Round 1: Pick & Speak organized by The Firm Club on 1.9.2017

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


The participants came from different streams of various semesters: 1st, 3rd, and 5th Semester students of BBA, B.Com and BCA.

Objectives

- A GD round is ideally conducted in order to understand a candidate's interpersonal skills. Since group discussions in an interview involve discussing topics with individuals you have never interacted with before, how well you're able to put across your point and are able to lead a discussion is judged upon, based on which how you can work in a team or lead them can be easily assessed.
- It also portrays to the interviewer a side of your attitude which you might probably display in your workplace.
- GD not only improves your listening skills, but also increases your confidence in speaking and helps you mould your attitude according to each group. Further, it also improves your ability to think critically and helps in problem solving.

Our Rivers Are Dying



The first round of "Our Voice" was Pick & Speak, held on Friday the 1st of September. Candidates had 1 minute to prepare on a random topic, given on the spot, and had 1 minute to speak about the topic. Out of 33 candidates, 20 were chosen to proceed to the next round.

The next round was held on the 4th of September in the UG Building's Seminar Hall, from 14:00 to 16:00. It saw the 20 candidates being put in 4 groups of 5 participants. A group was given a topic and the candidates had 1 minute each to present their views on that topic. Moreover, after that 1 minute each, they had a total of 5 minutes to discuss further points and to counter-argument each other.

The final round was held on the 6th of September in the UG Building's Seminar Hall, from 14:00 to 16:00. From the 20 candidates of Round 2, 8 finalists were chosen for the Debate Round. They were put in 2 groups of 4 and given 2 different topics. Professor Shuaib Ahmed Shariff presided over as the judge for the Debate Round.

Objectives

- **To foster critical thinking and listening skills.** Students involved in Speech & Debate develop higher-level thinking skills through application, analysis, synthesis, evaluation and creativity. They come to understand what they believe about the issues that confront them in our culture and why.
- **Increased problem-solving abilities** and overall academic performance. Various studies have shown that students who regularly participate in speech and debate activities tend to perform better than their peers in academic studies and tests.
- **To develop Research skills.** Speech and debate students learn more about their world and current affairs, its policies and value system which affect them and their communities as a whole.
- **To encourage Impromptu thinking and speaking.**
- **To build confidence under pressure.** Very often, students engaged in debates have to present compelling responses under pressure and should not waver on their points. Such situations provide a stimulus for building confidence under pressure, a skill which is crucial to survive in one's professional life.

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Event Procedure

Out of the 8 finalists, 2 groups of 4 students each were formed. The 2 groups each had their own distinct topics. From Group A, 2 students had to debate for and 2 students had to debate against. Each had 2 minutes to present their views. After the 4 candidates spoke, they had now 8 more minutes to debate between themselves. Once the deliberation was over, the Best Speaker was chosen from Group A. The same procedure ensued for Group B and another Best Speaker was chosen.

The 2 Best Speakers were then given another topic on the spot and had 2 minutes each to present their views. The final leg of Round 3 consisted of 5 minutes of debate between the 2 speakers, out of which a winner was declared. A Question & Answer session also ensued throughout the debate, whereby the audience had the opportunity to ask questions to the participants regarding their debate topics.


Brindavan College 'Culcurio Club' organised the Fresher's Day on 7th Oct. 2017.


The very purpose of the fresher's day was to welcome new comers in a friendly atmosphere, to encourage their creative impulses to boost their confidence.

Mr. Dileep, Student coordinator welcomed the guests and requested them to light the auspicious lamp in order to begin the day's celebration.


Prizes were distributed to the winners for the Rangoli competition for teaching and non-teaching staff which was held on 16th November 2017.
















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MANAGEMENT EXHIBITION

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Round 2 – Turn the Coat

The next round was held on the Friday 16th of February in the UG Building's Seminar Hall, from 14:00 to 16:00. Turn the Coat or Turncoat is an interesting format of debate where the speaker literally debates against himself. The speaker starts by taking a stance on the topic and switches sides after a specific duration of time or by taps. There may be multiple taps at regular or irregular intervals.

The candidate was called on stage and requested to select a chit of paper on which a specific topic was written. The candidate then had 5 mins to prepare on his assigned topic. He then had to come on stage and argue the pros and cons of that topic for duration of 3 minutes, during which a referee called for a 'switch' of stance at regular intervals (approx. 40 seconds). The student is then assessed on 4 criteria of: Fluency, Body Language, Content, and Presentation.

The event was judged by Mrs Sneha Singh and Mr Angel Chakraborty. The HOD of the Commerce & Management Department, Mr. Robert Utarid, as well as other teachers from the same department, was also present for this event.

Objectives

- To encourage Impromptu thinking and speaking.
- To stimulate multi-dimensional thinking. By requiring students to argue For and Against a specific topic, it spurs candidate to think about an issue from multi dimensions, rather than simply adopting one approach. This is desirable because it allows for greater intellectual penetration on the topic proposed.
- To build confidence under pressure. Very often, students engaged in debates have to present compelling responses under pressure and should not waver on their points. Such situations provide a stimulus for building confidence under pressure, a skill which is crucial to survive in one's professional life.

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


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

- **Dr. Selvaraj** spoke on Dalit and human rights







Report On Book Exhibition-Cum-Sale" 2018




The aim was to encourage and inculcate enthusiastic readers the love of reading among students. Hence the event turned out to be grandeur success.

(Held on Saturday, 29th September, 2018)







"Team Building And Leadership"



Round 2 – Turn the Coat

The next round was held on the Friday 16th of February in the UG Building's Seminar Hall, from 14:00 to 16:00. Turn the Coat or Turncoat is an interesting format of debate where the speaker literally debates against himself. The speaker starts by taking a stance on the topic and switches sides after a specific duration of time or by taps. There may be multiple taps at regular or irregular intervals.

The candidate was called on stage and requested to select a chit of paper on which a specific topic was written. The candidate then had 5 mins to prepare on his assigned topic. He then had to come on stage and argue the pros and cons of that topic for duration of 3 minutes, during which a referee called for a 'switch' of stance at regular intervals (approx. 40 seconds). The student is then assessed on 4 criteria of: Fluency, Body Language, Content, and Presentation.

The event was judged by Mrs Sneha Singh and Mr Angel Chakraborty. The HOD of the Commerce & Management Department, Mr. Robert Utarid, as well as other teachers from the same department, was also present for this event.

Objectives

- **To encourage Impromptu thinking and speaking.**
- **To stimulate multi-dimensional thinking.** By requiring students to argue For and Against a specific topic, it spurs candidate to think about an issue from multi dimensions, rather than simply adopting one approach. This is desirable because it allows for greater intellectual penetration on the topic proposed.
- **To build confidence under pressure.** Very often, students engaged in debates have to present compelling responses under pressure and should not waver on their points. Such situations provide a stimulus for building confidence under pressure, a skill which is crucial to survive in one's professional life.

International Women's Day is observed on 8 March in several countries across the globe. Every year it is celebrated with a particular theme.





Language is the blood of the soul into which thoughts run in and out. Language shapes the way we think and determine. It is the most powerful means of communication and an integral part of being human.



The event attracted three hundred and more visitors who took an opportunity to become acquainted with foreign culture and Indian culture.






Participants showcased their magazine, charts and models related to English, Hindi & Kannada Literature.







After the end of the event Fresher's Day was concluded with the hope of endurance and temptation to the dawn of another beginning of Fresher's...








REPORT ON GANDHI JAYANTHI CELEBRATION
